



Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) / Commercial Driver License (CDL) Residential Address Requirements

When applying for a CLP or a CDL, applicants must be a Florida resident and must present two proofs of Florida residential address **in their name**. Applicant must present one proof from List A and one proof from List B.
