



Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) / Commercial Driver License (CDL) Residential Address Requirements

When applying for a CLP or a CDL, applicants must be a Florida resident and must present two proofs of Florida residential address **in their name**.
Applicant must bring either two items from List A **OR** an item from List A and List B.

List A	List B
<p>(Item presented must be in the applicant's name)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence, with a term of 6 months or greater• Current Florida voter registration card• Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title• Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill• Current electricity or water bill• Recent cellular or landline telephone bill (must be dated within the last 30 to 60 days)• Recent internet service provider bill (must be dated within the last 30 to 60 days)• Latest property tax bill• Florida mortgage or property deed <p><u>If they do not have any of the above listed items:</u> Applicant must provide a Declaration of Domicile, filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the county in which the applicant resides, pursuant of FL Statutes, section 222.17 AND one proof from List B.</p>	<p>(Item presented must be in the applicant's name)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Latest W-2 form or 1099 form (must be dated within the last 6 months)• Recent bank statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)• Recent credit card statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)• Latest military orders• Recent pay stub (must be dated within the last 60 days)• Recent official government documents (must be dated within the last 60 days)

Certification of Address (HSMV-71120) cannot be used for CLP / CDL applicants.
