



Commercial Learner’s Permit (CLP) / Commercial Driver License (CDL) - Residency Requirements

When applying for an original CLP or CDL, applicants must prove Florida residency.
All applicants must present two proofs of Florida address in their name (no P.O. Box).
Applicant must bring two items from List A OR an item from List A and List B.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A current Florida Class E Driver License or Florida Identification card held for a period of more than six (6) consecutive months • A lease agreement, in the customer’s name, that has been in place for a period of more than six (6) consecutive months • A current residential mortgage, in the customer’s name, signed more than six (6) months ago • A current residential deed, in the customer’s name, signed more than six (6) months ago • A Florida Voter Registration Card • A statement of domicile pursuant to section 222.17, F.S. • A homestead tax exemption filing on property in this state 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence, with a term of 6 months or greater • Current Florida voter registration card • Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title • Current homeowner’s insurance policy or bill • Current electricity or water bill • Recent cellular or landline telephone bill* • Recent internet service provider bill* • Latest property tax bill • Florida mortgage or property deed • Declaration of Domicile <p><i>*Must be dated within the last 30 to 60 days</i></p>
